



Travel Bursary Policy

Community Exchange Event – Atlantic Region

Futurpreneur Canada will issue travel bursaries to select entrepreneurs for the purpose of easing the financial burden associated with attending the **Action Entrepreneurship Community Exchange** in Halifax on March 29th. Please direct any questions to aecanada@futurpreneur.ca.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a travel bursary, participants must:

- Live or work in Canada at least six months of the year
- Be 39 years of age or younger on May 30th, 2016
- Operate a business or plan to launch within the next 6 months
- Live or work at least 100 km away from the Futurpreneur Canada Atlantic Office (540 Southgate Drive, Suite 204, Bedford, NS B4A 0C9)

Bursary Amounts

If your application is successful, your Bursary amount will be determined based on your location. Please see below.

Once your attendance at the event has been confirmed, you will receive a bursary cheque in the mail approximately 3-6 weeks after the event. Please note that bursary cheques cannot be provided to entrepreneurs in advance of the event.

Hotel

Additional Terms and Conditions

- Travel must occur between March 22, 2016 and April 5, 2016 to be eligible for bursary.
- In order to secure reimbursement, the applicant must attend the **Action Entrepreneurship Community Exchange** in Halifax for the full duration of the event (8:00 am to 1:00 pm)
- Bursary will be issued to the eligible entrepreneur only and cannot be transferred to another person such as a business partner, friend or spouse.
- The reimbursement cheque will be sent to the entrepreneur by regular mail after their attendance at the event.
- Should the entrepreneur commit an illegal or fraudulent action or otherwise act in a manner that is considered to be inappropriate while traveling to and staying in Halifax, Futurpreneur Canada may choose to withdraw the offer of bursary.
- Futurpreneur Canada may refuse to grant a bursary at its sole discretion at any time.
